STANDARDS

European Standard EN 71, -Symbol

The painting instruments with the  symbol correspond to the safety requirements of the toy regulation COUNCIL DIRECTIVE (88/378/EEC) concerning the safety of toys* and thus to the European Standard EN 71. This standard restricts for example unavoidable traces of heavy metals.

ISO 11540

This standard regulates the danger of asphyxiation, particularly in the case of children, if caps are accidentally swallowed. Staedtler Fineliners and fibre tip pens meet the requirements of the ISO 11540 and are equipped with a ventilated protector cap.

DISPOSAL
