

The Crafter's Workshop Project

Slimline Dandelion Puffs Card

Products used:

- TCW2327 Slimline Dandelion Puffs stencil
- TCW9081 Pearl White Stencil Butter 2oz.
- TCW9061 Chartreuse Stencil Butter 2oz.
- TCW9062 Lime Green Stencil Butter 2oz.
- TCW9065 Fuchsia Stencil Butter 2oz.
- TCW9025 Plastic Palette knife
- TCW9051 Watercolor Paper Pack - cut one piece 3.25" x 8.25". Cut a second piece 8" x 9" and score/fold to 4" x 9".

Supplies needed:

- Large pan filled with water to drop stencil in.
- Paper Towels
- Light pink paper, cut: 3.5"x8.5"
- Paper Trimmer



Place the stencil over the cut watercolor paper and tape to your work surface.

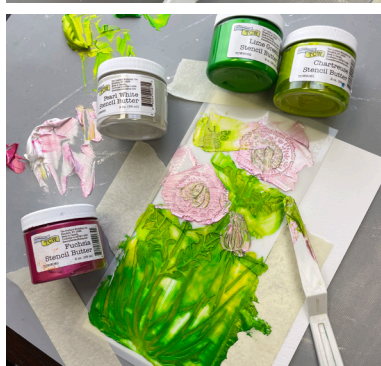
Apply a dollop of the Lime Green and the Chartreuse Stencil Butter to your work surface. Using the underside of the palette knife, pick up a little of both colors and allow to mix directly onto the stencil as you glide the Butter over the stencil. (see photo.)

Mix a small dot of Fuchsia with a large dollop of Pearl White.



Using the tip of the palette knife, apply the pink Stencil Butter to the flower puffs. If the colors mix a little, that's fine.

Once the entire stencil is covered, peel the stencil back from one corner to the opposite corner, rolling the stencil away from the project. Careful not to smudge.



Allow art to dry, and wash the stencil. Mount the artwork onto the pink layer, then mount onto the Slimline Card.
