

## The Crafter's Workshop Project Slimline Ocean Waves Card

## Products used:

- TCW2322 Slimline Ocean Waves stencil
- TCW9081 Pearl White Stencil Butter 2oz.
- TCW9057 Poolside ColorSparx® Powders
- TCW9025 Plastic Palette knife
- TCW9051 Watercolor Paper Pack cut one piece 3.25" x 8.25". Cut a second piece 8" x 9" and score/fold to 4" x 9".



## Supplies needed:

- Large pan filled with water to drop stencil in.
- Paper Towels
- Paper Trimmer
- Work Surface: Craft Mat or Palette Paper





Using a palette knife, put a dollop of Pearl White Stencil Butter on your work surface. Tap a little Cerulean Blue ColorSparx® powder next to it. Mix the Cerulean powder into the Butter until you don't see specks of powder. (Don't overmix. Leave some variations in shade.)



Place the Slimline Ocean Waves stencil onto the 3.25"x8.25" watercolor paper and tape down with removable tape as shown.

Scoop up some colored Stencil Butter and apply over the stencil. Use long smooth gliding motions in the same direction as the waves. Pick up a little plain white (uncolored) Pearl White Stencil Butter to create the foam on the tips of the waves. Cover completely. Wash palette knife.



Peel off stencil starting at one corner and "roll" it off the paper. Careful not to smudge. (Place stencil immediately in pan with water.) Let art dry, mount onto 4"x9" card.
